

Purposes and Goals

The Ouachita Baptist University Tiger Wrestling Camp has been designed to accommodate all ages and skill levels. Whether you have never wrestled before or are working toward your next state title, the Tiger Wrestling Camp will teach you the skills you need to accomplish your goals.

Wrestlers will be given instruction on the fundamentals of wrestling such as stance, motion, hand fighting and set ups, as well as advanced skills that will help them achieve a high level of success. The majority of the technique sessions will focus on the most important aspect of high school wrestling – scoring takedowns from the neutral position. We will focus on strong set-ups, leg attacks and high percentage finishes. The combination of technique and live wrestling sessions will give participants the opportunity to apply the skills they learn throughout the camp.

Other areas of focus during the camp will be a series of pinning combinations, breakdowns, rides, and escapes. The techniques will be taught by our expert clinicians along with members of the OBU Wrestling team. Each camper will experience one-on-one instruction to insure they will be able to properly learn all of the techniques shown.

Registration

Registration for camp will be from 12 noon to 4 p.m. on Monday, July 2, at Flippen-Perrin Residence Hall on the OBU campus.

What to Bring

Each camper will be expected to supply his own bedding (twin size), towels, workout gear, shoes, etc. Laundry facilities are available on campus, but each camper should bring enough gear to limit laundry to a minimum.

Facilities and Housing

All campers will stay in one of Ouachita's residence halls. Two campers will be assigned to each room at check-in on Monday afternoon. Campers may request a roommate on the application. All campers will eat in the Ouachita Commons, the university's state-of-the-art dining hall, which offers a well-balanced, all-you-can-eat meal plan.

Supervision and Rules

Participants in the camp will be supervised during all organized camp sessions and in the dorms. Campers will be required to attend all scheduled camp sessions and activities. Campers will be required to abide by all rules and regulations that students at Ouachita Baptist University are required to follow. Any violation of these rules will cause immediate dismissal from camp without a refund.

We will use every precaution to prevent accidents. We do not, however, assume any responsibility for medical, dental or other expenses incurred as a result of an accident. A parent or guardian must sign the application before an athlete will be accepted into camp.

Cost of Camp

The cost of Tiger Wrestling Camp is \$340. A discount of \$20 per person will be given to groups of 10 or more. Group applications MUST be received in one envelope. A \$100 deposit is due with this application. The balance is due and payable upon registration.

Camp tuition covers instruction, housing, meals, secondary insurance and camp T-shirt. Lodging will be available after check-in on Monday, and the first meal will be supper on Monday evening. Breakfast will be served on Friday morning before the camp tournament and will be the last meal served.
